Rainbow Bridge welcomed Lisa when she reunited with her own beloved dogs. We are sure other Shelties paid heed to her arrival as well. Her interest in history and especially as it related to the background of our breed would have been appreciated and acknowledged by those still awaiting the arrival of their special person. Meanwhile those who are being waited for will also miss her knowledge and input. Her accumulated information was readily available to any and all who sought it as she welcomed inquires. Artistic herself and computer literate, she used her skills to respond with a few keystrokes to locations where pictures of specific dogs could be found or historical articles that either confirmed or negated much that was considered "wives tales" with regard to the breed. She will be greatly missed as both a friend and a "go to" person for those seeking such information and or had the joy of sharing a friendship with her. We who were privileged to have known her personally, her family, and the breed itself, suffered a great loss with her passing. Here is a quote from her sisters Allison and Heidi "Lisa is playing with her puppies again".

Lisa was born on July 2nd 1953 And passed away during the morning of June 22nd 2013

Lisa's own introduction of herself to a small private chat group over ten years ago.

"I have led a pretty boring life.

Before I got into computer programming I was a bum. I was in the Who's Who of American High School Students, Phi Theta Kappa in Junior College and dropped out of college in my junior year. Belonged to many dog clubs in different parts of the country and was even President of Chief Solano all-breed club as the "mediator" candidate.

Had jobs as kennel manager/licensed assistant handler, radio station traffic manager, ground ops manager at a gliderport and at an ultralight aircraft training center/dealership (we lost quite a few customers at that one - as in "nearer my god to thee").

Then I learned computers and I spent the last 20 years spinning bits. Some times I felt like Rapunzel, except I've been trapped in cubicles or my car instead of a tower. I had horrendous up-to-5 hour commutes until I moved to Ohio 4 years ago.

The most interesting place I worked was the 5th Army headquarters at the Presidio of California, right next to the Golden Gate Bridge. It used to scare the heck out of me when they held the monthly retirement ceremonies on the parade grounds right under our window and fired off a cannon.

I used to read a lot - mostly history, anthropology, archaeology, dinosaurs & physics. Don't read much fiction except for Michener, Tom Clancy & Dick Francis. A couple of my all time favorite books are "The Making of The Atomic Bomb", "Dinosaur Heresies", Mary Leakey's "Disclosing The Past" and Ben Bradlee's "A Good Life".

I do some sketching sometimes, there are two examples on my website. (See the sketches included in the picture of Lisa that heads this page. Editor). I have done wood carvings of ducks and won an honorable mention with my second carving at

I have done wood carvings of ducks and won an honorable mention with my second carving at the only decoy show I entered. Three dimensional art is a real challenge. I also crocheted a bedspread, needlepointed a rug and some pillows and have a quilt almost ready to put the backing on.

I'm an abject failure as a dog breeder, having one bought Champion and one litter from her. Last 4 tries at getting a litter yielded nothing.

I do love pedigrees and in 1994 I started programming my own database and have 150,000 Shelties on file. Have been trying to locate pictures of all the American Champions that have finished and have found around 85% of them so far. I think my database is a little more useful than others. While I haven't done the inbreeding coefficient thing yet, I can tell you what impact particular individuals have had on the breed. I don't know of any other programs that can do the descendent, male line and female family listings that mine can do. I get lots of requests for stuff and am happy to try to answer them if I can.

This is kinda weird, but I am part of a composite character in the book "Winners Bitch". "Lisa"

The Loss of A Great One

The Saturday morning was as pleasant of a beginning as one could wish for on a summer day in June. Cool and slightly crisp with a lovely blue sky and big puffy white clouds lazily making their way across the sky. The sounds of birds filled the air as they flitted back and forth around the fields and yard. The sun, not overly bright was casting a warm golden glow on everything beneath her, promising more warmth as the day unfolded. The air scented with the slight hint of wild honeysuckle. A day so filled with such promise, that one wants to capture it and keep it forever.

And it was on this day, this day so seemingly perfect, that my phone rang to deliver the news that has forever left a mark on my soul. For this is the day that I received the news that my close friend, Lisa Porch, left this world to be in another, to once again be with her beloved shelties that preceded her.

Although I always knew that this news would be coming, since the first phone call in March notifying me of her condition, I never ever wanted to receive that call and certainly not on such a day as this. But then again, it was the type of day that Lisa loved. What would be a better day to leave those of us behind? Certainly not a day filed with clouds and gray. She would call me from California in the middle of winter and tell me about the sky, the breeze and the warmth. None of those terms describe a winter day in central Ohio. But I'm getting ahead of myself.

It all started over a decade ago when reading a post on the yahoo sheltie group list from someone in California who was searching for information about central Ohio, specifically the Columbus metro area. Seems she was relocating for work purposes and wanted info on the suburbs. I responded to the message, and stated that I could offer assistance if needed. I left my name and phone number for her to contact if I could help. What happened next was the beginning of a friendship that felt as if we had known one another since childhood.

Lisa contacted me and that first phone call was typical of many others we had, it lasted for hours. In her I discovered somewhat of a kindred soul who had a zeal for the history behind the dogs we owned. Her knowledge base on the subject was infinite. She could recall family lines and dogs with incredible speed and accuracy. Yet her knowledge didn't stop there. She had first hand intimate knowledge of many of the dogs that I admired and only knew of through the accounts I had read in the breed journals.

She was present during the beginning events of what we today think of as when the shelties came into their own. The Mauldin's at Kismet employed her when High Born was a young dog. She told me tales of his antics there and the special bond between him and Mr. Mauldin. She was on the other end of the leash of one of the more well known pictures of Banger as a young dog. She watched and observed Peter as he grew up along with a younger Mr. Coen. She helped Irene Brody launch one of the first Sheltie magazines. And always was on this quest for more knowledge about this breed that she loved so passionately.

This passion lead her to acquire an entire collection of Stud Books going back to the late 1800's, including the English Stud Books to further her research. Her personnel library was so vast that she required custom made bookcases to house them. When I saw her collection, I was just stunned by the quality and quantity. She created a computer database where she not only cataloged a dog's lineage, but also included any known published photographs as references. She could trace a dog back to the original imports as well as all of the siblings in a litter. With a click on her keyboard, she could produce production records for any dog asked. Or follow the titles within a family. In addition to being able to produce all of this factual information, she could also remember the minute details of any dog she went over. She was probably the keenest observer of animals that I have ever encountered. And yet, many of the fancy did not even know of her existence. Many still do not realize all the parts she has played, where her contributions exist even today on your own bookshelves and knowledge base.

Lisa was the type of person that generally was overlooked by most people. She was quiet and did not strike up a conversation easily with strangers. But every animal always knew she was present, and not just dogs. She had a quality about her that spoke to those of the animal kingdom. I saw it on many occasions with my own vast menagerie, as well as others. And they all loved Lisa; she drew them like a magnet. Even my most devoted sheltie would leave my side and go to hers if she asked.

So Lisa eventually came to Ohio from California and while she was searching for a suitable house, her girls came and stayed with me. And what an interesting time we all had together for those months until Lisa found a house. I can remember the first day that they were with me. Lisa unloaded them; there were three sables and one blue merle. My household was made up of all AOAC's at that time. Kelsie, Lisa's AOAC came out of the crate looked at my dogs and plopped herself down amongst them as if to say, "Well, finally, I'm not the odd one out!" Kelsie always kept more with my group than the remaining sables. The other girls were Nina (the princess) and her two daughters, Ursula and Simone.

Nina was a graceful princess and never liked to get her feet wet in the grass. There must not have been much dew in California, because every time we had it here (which is frequent), Nina would go down the borders of the gardens where no grass grew until she reached a sunny spot

before she would get into the grass and potty. And then retrace her steps back to the house or deck. She was tolerant of all the AOAC's that she clearly felt were her subjects and never really socialized with them. But was content to 'rule' her kingdom from the couch.

Ursula was truly a one-person dog and her person was Lisa. After Lisa headed back to California to pack up her house there, Ursula went on a hunger strike. The first day or so, I didn't worry, but by the third day when she wouldn't even go outside, I called Lisa and explained the situation. Lisa had me hold the phone to Ursula and talked to her. After their conversation, I got back on the phone with Lisa and she told me things would be OK. I hung up and Ursula asked to go outside. After that phone call, I never did have another problem with Ursula eating. I always knew when the phone rang if it was Lisa, because Ursula would go to the phone and wait. Lisa would talk to her and then me. Ursula would never go to the phone if it wasn't Lisa. As an aside, Lisa never called on a schedule, so the only explanation I know is that the bond was so strong between them that Ursula always knew when it was Lisa on the ringing phone.

Simone, well to say her name is to smile. You know the kind of smile that makes your eyes twinkle and dance. Simone could be everybody's friend, if you allowed it. She never forced herself on anyone, but was always there in the background waiting. Waiting to be noticed, waiting to be called, waiting to belong and waiting for acknowledgement. She had an impish, subtle sense of humor, the kind that makes your belly jiggle when you laugh. And her antics never harmed anyone or thing, just a good jest. And when you 'got' her humor her eyes just sparkled. Simone was probably one of the most intelligent shelties that I ever met. The wheels were always turning, always thinking.

Lisa, eventually found a house that suited her purpose and the girls moved out. Our friendship continued to grow and develop. Lisa became a mentor for me and I never tired listening and learning from her. She was the first person I encountered who evaluated a dog entirely on the merits they possessed, knowing that faults are always present. She taught me that the faults could be corrected, but the virtues hard to create, thereby all the more valuable. She gave me a new perspective in which to evaluate my direction, based on the history behind the lines. She was an honest evaluator, who never overly criticized a dog. But sought to understand why the dog possessed its imperfections and where they came from.

Lisa never tired of my countless questions and patiently went over my dogs with me to understand better form and function along with the historical background. We would go back and forth over dogs, both hers and mine until I thoroughly understood and could 'feel' it. She was an excellent teacher in the finer points of the Standard. She was the first person to get me to truly understand the 'corners' on the skull.

And then there was the history of the development of the breed itself. Here we shared another quest. We both devoured information about the islands, the culture, the social status, and the economic pressures faced by the islanders. Not just the previous century either, but back to the 1400 and 1500 hundreds or earlier. To understand the breed, you need to understand the people and their history. I dare say that Lisa knew more about the island and its people than most of the British, outside of the islanders themselves. Her knowledge far outranks mine, but I'm still learning.

There have been similar days since that Saturday in June when I received the call. There have been days with the sky as blue and the clouds rolling by. These are the days that I remember Lisa the most. These are the days when my heart has an ache that is hard to dull. This is when I feel the loss of a friend so dear. This is when I think of the loss of the knowledge that the entire fancy may now endure.

The result of Lisa's labor of love, her collection of books, and her computer program are now dispensed to various locations. Lisa's illness included some memory issues, so the passwords to the program may have been lost. There are efforts to unlock the program so that the information is not entirely gone. I pray for the success of Tom and Bob's efforts, because her work can never be truly duplicated. Some of you may see part of her collection in the historical items of the ASSA. Others have gone to universities for a wider range of dog lovers to utilize. And some have been given to people that Lisa's sisters felt she would want them to have. I feel very privileged to have some items from Lisa, to be worthy in their and her eyes.

In remembering Lisa, I now realize that part of her is reflected in each of her dogs she shared for a brief time with me. There's Nina, who always felt a bit apart from the group, always gracious and kind, but never quite fitting in. There's Kelsie, that when she was amongst her own kind, felt at home and part of a group. I like to think that Lisa could feel at home in my company.

Next is Ursula, whose loyalty reached almost to the point of a fault and never waived in her devotion. Then we have Simone, whose subtle humor and intelligence could just take your breath away. All of these attributes can be applied to Lisa. She was my friend and a confident. She shared many of my hopes and dreams with my dogs. She encouraged me to persevere in times of loss and stood behind me so I would not fall. She was a true friend in that she totally accepted me for who and what I am, good, bad, or indifferent.

There is a claim that 'only the good die young' and I consider slightly short of sixty years to be young. You never realize how 'great' something or someone is until they are gone. In the present you know they are good, but with their passing you realize the greatness. And so it is with Lisa. When I remember the 'greats' in the likeness of Peter and High Born and Reflection, and POW, I will remember Lisa right along side of them all. For greatness, like beauty is in the eye of the beholder, and in my eyes few reach that height.

So for now it is adieu my friend. May you find peace amongst the gentle breezes in the forest or upon the rocky cliffs of an ocean. May your ears be listening to the soft sounds of the earth and your gentle spirit free to roam. Until another time and place finds us both, I will look for you amongst the clouds and in the twinkle of my sheltie's eyes. And know that I will remember you always and feel privileged to have called you friend.




## **Shelties Of The Past**

SHETLAND SHEEPDOG Peerie Dog; Toonie Dog



The celebrated Shetland Pony is really diminu-tive—so also is the Shetland Sheepdog. A perfect Collie in miniature, the Shetland is efficient and nimble, slowly becoming known among the multitude of competitors. It was originally bred in the Orkneys and Outer Hebrides a far west as St. Kildas, from small sheep-herding Collies taken there from the Scottish mainland about 150 years ago. At Lerwick in 1008 the Fancy was sufficiently strong to found the Shet-and Collie Club (a title which a year later was changed to the Shetland Sheepdog Club), and from then onwards this Collie-bred race became better known. Meight 12–15 in. Weight about 14 lb. Colour, sable, sable-and-white, tan-and-white, tricolour, blue-merle and black-and-tan. 
